Tutor Tips, Techniques:

Want to brush up on your tutoring strategies or take a peek at how experienced tutors are working on fluency, comprehension, phonics and decoding with adult learners?

Our program highly recommends the excellent tutor training videos posted for all to view on YouTube by San Jose Public Libraries' *Partners in Reading Program*. These are brief (5 to 10 minute) videos of adult learners working with experienced tutors or trainers and focusing on core adult literacy skills – so you can chose to watch just those you and your adult learner are currently working on. If you are brand new to tutoring, there are 1-4 videos on how to approach your first meetings together.

On YouTube, just search for: *Partners in Reading* and you'll see all the videos available from this San Jose Public Libraries' training program. They are organized by literacy topic and skill.
